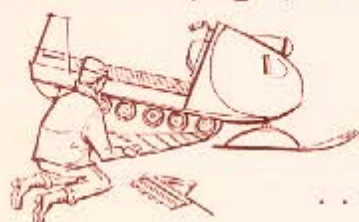

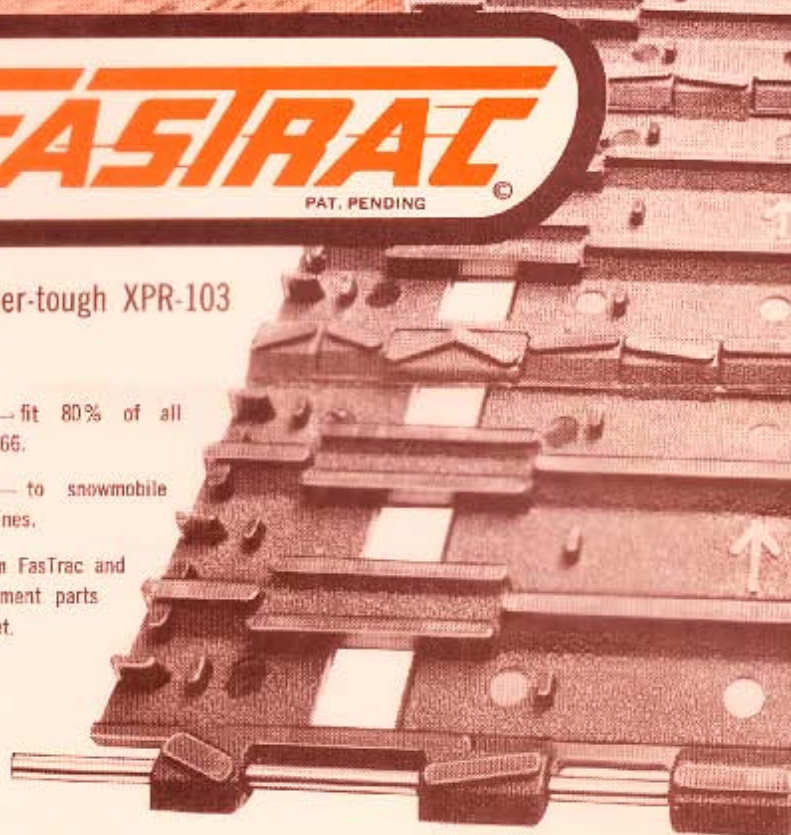

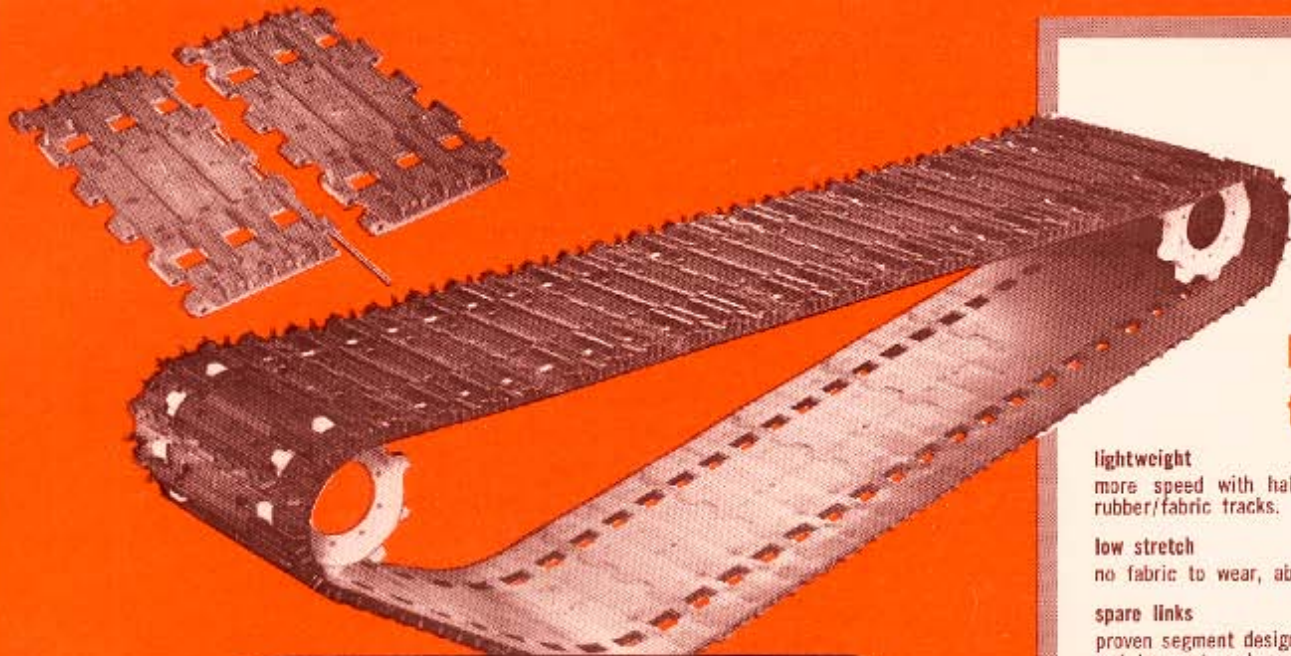

For assembly you simply cut off old track (no need to drop undercarriage or realign bogies, sprockets or other parts). Unbox FasTrac. Slide through the drive assembly. Using only a "lead dowel" and hammer, connect the two FasTrac ends with the locking steel rod provided. That's all! Takes 20 minutes or less!

FasTrac fits most sleds with a 15" or 18" track using dual drive, 2" pitch sprockets. To determine if FasTrac Model "J" will fit your sled measure your old track from the center of one sprocket hole to the center of the next. This should measure 2" (this is the pitch). Next, measure the center-to-center hole distance across the track. This should measure 9", if not, you may have to reposition your sprockets.

Since writing to you the early part of October of this year for a brochure on "Fastrac", which I thank you for sending, I purchased one such track (18") for my snowmobile.


Gentlemen, I cannot praise that track enough. Words just simply will not describe the satisfaction I have found in the performance it has put into my machine.
